AGM - 16 February

Ovington Inlands - 19/20 March

As a heads up for this event, the entry will open on 22nd February and there will be two tracks so the Flying Fifteens/OKs/Phantoms will sail trapezoid or W/L and not be on the Club track. This means that any 15's not entering the event but racing on Sunday will need to sail the normal club course and will not be able to join in for one day without formally entering the event.

Classic Fifteen available

Below is an extract from an email from Graham Lamond. If you are interested in 647 or know somebody who is, please let me know and I'll put you on contact with Graham.

A quick bit of background about me. I have been sailing Fifteens since the early

90s and currently have two classics, 617 & 1155, both wooden boats by Chippendale. The other is 3428, an Ovington MkIX with a wooden deck by Arnott Dobson (I like my wood!). I also have two wooden Albacores which I sail at my home club, Ripon SC, as they don't allow anything over 15'.

Together with a fellow Fifteener, Jordan Aspin, we arranged via Tim O'Brien to

hold the first Classic and Silver meeting at Grafham last year. Jordan went, but my daughter visited us the previous weekend and then notified us on the Monday that she had tested positive for Covid, so we had no choice but to isolate and miss the event. I wasn't best pleased as you can imagine! Anyway we have gone for Grafham again this year and I shall be there with 617. We're hoping that numbers will be better this time as restrictions are lifted and people are more willing to travel.

My question is would you be interested in a Classic Fifteen?

The boat in question is 647, September Song, built by Richard Watson and is all wood. Richard gave her to me as he is now too old to sail and she had sat

for many years and had to be moved from where she was kept. I found a new owner for her but he contacted me just before Christmas to say he now won't have time to do the work, which is a shame as he had previously restored another wooden Fifteen to a high standard.

Anyway 647 is currently in dry storage in Northwich and is saveable with work. She will be free to the new owner and I'm happy to go and get her (I live in

North Yorkshire) for the right owner. She is complete and the sails are in nice

condition. She also has her paperwork and the advantage that Richard Watson

is still alive and happy to talk about her. She is very much a race boat of her time and has a number of features which were hi tech at the time that are also worth saving.

If you or anyone you know might be interested, I have plenty of photos of her I can send to you and I can go into more detail. I'd hate to lose her but she
