Members' Dashboard


The member's dashboard provides a home for all the useful resources you'll need as a member such as:

- Webcams
- Live Weather

Webcams

Grafham WebCams

Click on the required image to view the live feed in full screen.



There's 3 webcam views to give you a good view of the water. This is helpful for determining if the conditions are suitable for sailing before you need to leave home. You can also view the safety flag at the coxswain shed on the east webcam to make sure the lake is open for the activity you're planning to do.



If you're not sure what the flags mean, you can see them on the Safety Flags page accessed from the Members' Dashboard or from this link.

Live Weather

Grafham has a live weather station on top of the club house to give useful readings on the current sailing conditions. It provides:

- Wind strength
- Wind gusts
- Wind direction
- Atmospheric pressure

The readings are accurate but they can underread when the direction is from the south and goes over the village so bear that in mind on a windy day.
